

The WCHRI Science Shop Program: Summer Studentship in Community-Based Research (CBR) is a competitive granting opportunity that offers students from all departments and disciplines an opportunity to become involved in a community-based research project during the summer months (May to August). This program is intended to develop the applicant's interest and skills in community-based research relevant to women and/or children's health. The program is a training opportunity that brings together University of Alberta students and community organizations in pursuing summer research projects that are mutually beneficial.

The WCHRI Science Shop Summer Student award, valued at up to **\$1,300** per month is offered for the summer months of May to August. Incentive awards (of up to \$250 per month) are also available for those who have been successful in obtaining both the WCHRI Summer

Student award as well as another peer-reviewed competitive summer studentship award.
